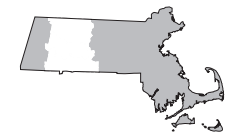
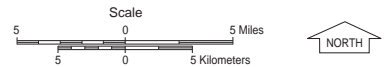
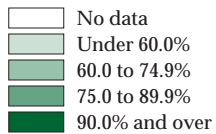
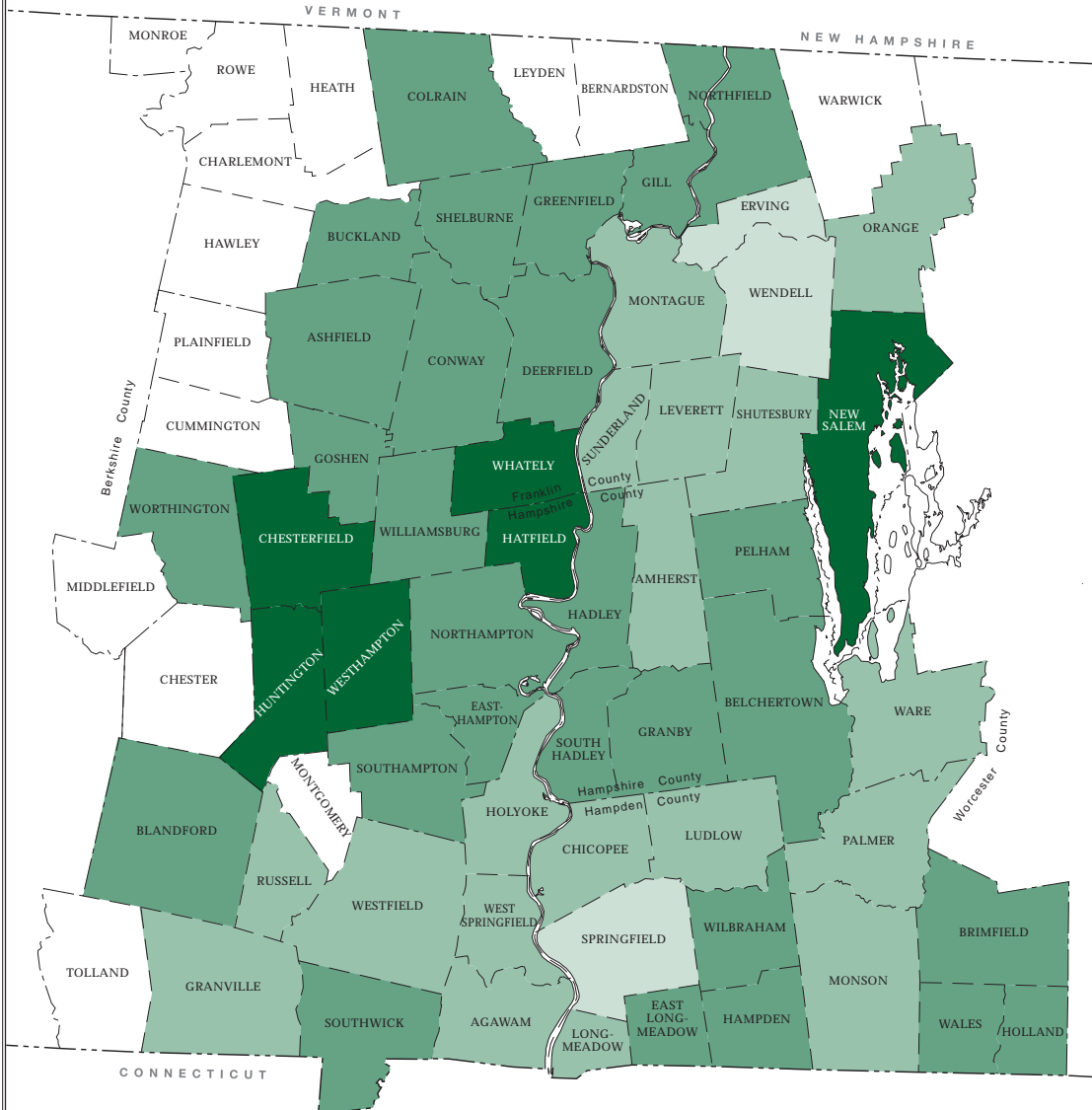


Percent of Pregnancies for which Adequate Prenatal Care was Received (Kessner Index), 2005
