2015 - 2018 Pioneer Valley Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Proposed Amendments – May 2015

FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2015 Part 1A: Federal Aid Target Projects

- Increase total programmed amount for Springfield-North end at Brightwood (605222) from \$6,033.000 to \$6,172,363. New STP total is \$3,797,632.
- Remove Wilbraham Boston Road Reconstruction (607869) \$1,983,402 (STP). Project is proposed to be funded in FFY 2016 element of the FFY 2016-FFY 2019 TIP.
- Add Hadley Sidewalk and Wheelchair Ramp Construction on Route 9 (608023) for \$1,300,000 to fill funding gap left by Boston Road in Wilbraham.

701 CMR 7.00 Use of Road Flaggers and Police Details on Public Works Projects / 701 CMR 7.00 (the Regulation) was promulgated and became law on October 3, 2008. Under this Regulation, the CMR is applicable to any Public works Project that is performed within the limits of, or that impact traffic on, any Public Road. The Municipal Limitation referenced in this Regulation is applicable only to projects where the Municipality is the Awarding Authority. For all projects contained in the TIP, the Commonwealth is the Awarding Authority. Therefore, all projects must be considered and implemented in accordance with 701 CMR 7.00, and the Road Flagger and Police Detail Guidelines. By placing a project on the TIP, the Municipality acknowledges that 701 CMR 7.00 is applicable to its project and design and construction will be fully compliant with this Regulation.
