The Massachusetts Department of Transportation and the Vermont Agency of Transportation are leading a regional intercity rail study known as the Northern New England Intercity Rail Initiative (NNEIRI).

What is this rail study?

- The proposed service will provide both long-distance and regional passenger train services along the 470-mile corridor.
- These trains will cover longer distances than commuter trains and connect communities across New England, Quebec, and New York.
