In 1948, with the formal dedication of Ware's Veterans' Memorial Field, the town made a commitment to provide an active recreational facility for its residents within the town center. They felt it was important for the welfare of their youth and spirit of the community. Now, 66 years later, the town has reaffirmed that commitment by providing state-of-the-art field lighting and improved accessibility. Under the jurisdiction of the Ware Parks and Recreation Department, these improvements are intended to offer additional playing time for youth sports teams, as well as for other approved activities for all Ware residents and organizations.
