

# **HATFIELD**

Hatfield is a farming and residential community located 25 miles north of Springfield in the Connecticut River Valley. The Connecticut River wraps around Hatfield, forming its southern and eastern boundaries. Its wide flood plain made Hatfield a prime location for agriculture. Topography ranges from level land along the Connecticut River in the east, becoming gradually more hilly toward the western border

Active farms produce crops of potatoes, corn, squash, strawberries, and field tobacco. Interstate 91, which runs through the center of Hatfield, has also attracted a number of industries here since its construction. Some of these industries include the manufacture of pipe, chemicals, windows, furniture, wood products, fertilizer, and food distribution.

Hatfield is made up of three villages: Hatfield Center, North Hatfield, and West Hatfield. Hatfield Center has a broad treeshaded thoroughfare lined by beautiful colonial homes. North Hatfield is a small residential area surrounded by agricultural land. West Hatfield contains woods and hills, as well as the major highways and industries in town.

The town's high school, Smith Academy, was founded by local resident Sophia Smith in the late 1800's. Sophia was also responsible for founding Smith College in Northampton.
