PLAINFIELD

Located at the northwest tip of Hampshire County, amid the beauty of the Berkshire Mountains, Plainfield was home to 605 residents in 2014. Many newcomers are employed as craftsmen, artisans, or have the capability to work out of home offices. However, the majority of the workforce commutes out of town.

Plainfield was settled around 1770 as a part of Cummington, and incorporated as its own community in 1785. The landscape varies from rugged, forested hills reaching altitudes of almost 1,700 feet to active agricultural sites, such as a a saw mill, a dairy farm, and a multi-purpose farm for various crops. Plainfield is also home to a portion of the Hawley State Forest.

The majority of developed land is in agriculture, followed by residential uses. Children participate in a regional school district in Shelburne Falls.
