

Q5 How would you rate Hadley as a place for people to live as they age?



Q6 How important is it for you to remain in Hadley as you get older?






Q10 When do you plan to retire?


Q11 How important is it for you to be able to stay in your own home, either independently or with a caregiver, as you age?












The #2 priority for Hadley to focus on in the next five years to make the town a more livable community for older adults









Q35 Which of the following programs or services did you access in the last 12 months? (check all that apply)






