Community Development


- City receives Entitlement Grant every year

- Funding can be utilized for exterior building improvements (storefront windows, doors, signs, etc.)
- Not for interior improvements or structural repairs (roof, etc.)


- Powered by Interise, in Springfield since 2019

Brownfields

- \$500,000 EPA Grant Award
- July 2023
- Utilized for site assessments citywide
- Mason Square/Six Corners target areas
- Also partner with MassDevelopment on Brownfields funding





Markets/Food access










Bikeshare
