





2. What is your age?





6. How would you rate Ware as a place for people to live as they age?






7. How important is it for you to remain in Ware as you get older?






16. How important is it for you to be able to stay in your own home, either independently or with a caregiver, as you age?








38. Do you think an urgent care clinic is needed in Ware?






42. Before the COVID stay at home order (March 2020), how often did you get together in person with family, friends or neighbors?


